RTL UPDATE: "HAPPY NEW YEAR" FOR WOMEN TODAY?

A study done by the National Cancer Institute in Washington found that women who had an abortion increased their risk of getting breast cancer by 50 percent. This risk was more than doubled if the woman's abortion (or first abortion) took place before the age of 18 or over the age of 30. The connection between abortion and breast cancer has been found in numerous scientific studies by medical professionals throughout the world.

If considering a surgery that wasn't physically necessary, wouldn't it be important to know that the surgery could increase the risk for a disease that will kill an estimated more than 40,000 people in 2009. Isn't it a woman's right to know that she is putting herself at greater risk for a serious and potentially deadly disease by having an abortion? All women have the right to know the possible consequences of abortion and the link between abortion and breast cancer.

Also, the Food and Drug Administration released an "adverse event summary" for the abortion drug mifepristone, also known as RU-486. The report indicates that 14 women in the United States have died after taking the abortion drug.
